

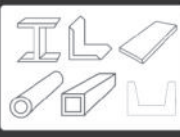

All 92 students, every single one of them, suddenly SNEEZED!

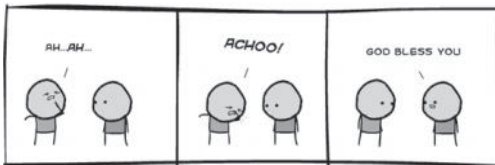
The student on stage simply looked at the audience and said, 'GOD BLESS YOU'

🐸 **George the Snail, the Last of His Kind, Dies!** The last known /Achatinella apexfulva/ snail in the Hawaiian Islands, died on New Year's Day, 2019. He was 14-years old and really slowed down over the year. Old George won't be leaving any more silvery trails in his wake.



He is the last known snail of his species. "For a snail, he was a little bit of a hermit," said David Sischo, a wildlife biologist with the Hawaii Invertebrate Program. "I very rarely saw him



outside of his shell." He will be missed by hundreds of school children who had viewed him over the years.

🐸 **Facebook Bans Evangelist Franklin Graham for Hate Speech:** Graham has revealed that he was recently suspended from Facebook for taking a stand for his biblical beliefs. Graham says it's just wrong that his biblical comments would be ever considered "hate speech." The temporary ban lasted 24 hours, and while the censorship itself is shocking enough, it was also surprising that the ban was retroactive, resulting from a comment he made two years ago. "Well, now we know. Facebook has a secret rulebook for policing speech. I was banned from posting on Facebook last week for 24 hours. Why? Because of a post from back in 2016 about North Carolina's House Bill 2 (the bathroom bill)," Graham explained. "Facebook said the post went against their 'community standards on hate speech.' The suspension raises serious questions as critics ask, if Facebook is willing to block one of the most prominent Christian leaders in the world, then what's next?"

🐸 *(according to USA Today's Erik Brady)* **The NFL did not allow a Super Bowl commercial made by veterans (AMVETS) that asks people to stand for the flag.** A spokesperson for the vets said, "So their logic, it is okay to protest against the flag but not okay to protest for it!"

🐸 **An 86-year-old woman was arrested** for calling emergency services because she couldn't get a pizza delivered. Dorothy Densmore, of Charlotte, NC, spent two nights behind bars after dialing '911' 20 times in 38 minutes. Angry she could not get the pizza delivered to her home, she demanded police arrest the pizza owner. She told police that she had been called a 'crazy old coot' by someone at the pizza shop. A police spokeswoman said the 5ft. tall 105 lb. octogenarian scratched, kicked and bit the hand of the officer. She was released from jail, pending a court appearance, after a judge ordered a medical evaluation.

🐸 **Democrat Blocked Senate Bill That Would Prevent Infanticide to Protect Babies Who Survive Abortion.** Sen. Patty Murray (D-WA) blocked a Republican-led bill that would have required doctors to care for babies who are born alive after surviving a failed abortion attempt. Sen. Ben Sasse (R-Neb) requested the unanimous consent vote last week after Virginia Democratic Gov. Ralph Northam suggested that some babies should be allowed to die right after they're born or "would be resuscitated if that's what the mother and the family desired." Sasse's bill would have built on the 2002 Born-Alive Infants Protection Act, which said that "every infant member of the species homo sapiens who is born alive at any stage of development" is recognized as a "person" under federal law.

🐸 **Man Stabs Pregnant Woman and Baby to Death - No Charges for Killing Child** because of the recently passed NY Abortion Law. A pregnant woman was stabbed to death on Feb. 3rd. She was 5 months pregnant and already the mother of a young child when a man brutally stabbed her and her unborn baby to death. The boyfriend, 48-year-old Anthony Hobson was initially charged with abortion in the second degree for the death of the lady's unborn child and 2nd. degree murder for her death. But the Queen's District Attorney's office dropped the abortion charge against him because New York's new "Reproductive Health Act" (RHA) legalizes abortion until the moment of birth and removes abortion from the state's criminal code.
